A new National Policing website recently went live which is up to date with all contacts, complete with names and faces, meetings and events scheduled and accurate breakdown of crimes with a crime map. You can easily obtain all your local information including crime figures by entering your postcode on

There is also an app available on all app stores which is a mini version with the same information and mirrors local police sites and is recommended for anyone to download as a very useful tool.

Crimes can be reported here as well as 101 and you should get a crime reference immediately. The response time has a 24 hour turnaround.

Neighbourhood alerts are a useful way to help the Police to connect with communities. It tells people what is happening in their area and allows them to respond directly with any information. Residents are encouraged to sign up at
