**Lane Lamp** 

The Senior Council Officer reported that National Grid will not allow a new lamp on the telegraph pole following the removal of the old one. The Committee considered quotes to complete the project:

RESOLVED: To recommend to full Council:

- i. For National Grid to decommission existing lamp and disconnect unmetered supply at a cost of £477.02 plus VAT if the quote is still valid. Obtain a revised quote and consider under delegated powers by the Clerk and Committee Chair.
- ii. To give delegated powers to the Committee Chair and Clerk to agree the quote for the groundworks by Countryside and Garden as the quote was not received in time for the meeting.
- iii. To accept a quote from Wayne McGrail to assemble the lamp at an estimated cost of £120 plus VAT.
- iv. To replace lamp with a 45w Solar LED street light and column from Wydels Electrical Wholesalers. To be located on Chicken Lane next to Tweedies field. The Academy have given permission for it to be installed on the land behind the wall opposite the existing lamp and the work to be carried out during the school holidays.
