Just a reminder that you can report the following Highway problems on the Devon County Council website:

- Pothole
- Public rights of way
- Defective road markings or signs
- Broken manhole cover
- Fences and barriers
- Flooding and blocked drains
- Parking
- Hazardous or fallen tree/branch
- Trip hazard
- Grit bin
- Ice
- Overgrown vegetation
- Debris or obstruction
- Traffic lights
- Bridges and retaining walls
- Street Lights, lit signs, bollards
